

Benoit Fromanger is the newly-appointed Principal Chief Conductor of the Bucharest Symphony Orchestra.

Recognised internationally as a conductor of the highest level, Benoit Fromanger's goal is to bring and share, for every concert, his personal approach to music, his human respect for the musicians and the audience, his energy, generosity as well as his passion.

Recent engagements have included performances in famous festivals where he notably conducts the Montréal Métropolitan Orchestra, the Ankara Presidential Orchestra, the Bursa Philharmonic Orchestra (Turkey), the Kuhmo Virtuosi (Finland), the Innsbrucker kammerorchester, the Tianjin Philharmonic Orchestra (China), the Dokuz Eylul Symphony Orchestra (Deso Izmir), the Toulouse National Chamber Orchestra , the Munich Baroque Soloists , the Prague Chamber Orchestra , the Orchestre Ostinato of Paris.

Upcoming highlights include concerts with the Adana Philharmonic Orchestra, the Camerata Antiqua de Curitiba (Brasil), the Bursa Symphony, the Georgian sinfonietta, the Bucharest Symphony.

Prize-winner of the Paris conservatory B.F began his musical career as Principal soloist of the Paris National Opera orchestra .Ten years later he moved to Munich where he join as Principal soloist the "Symphonie Orchester des Bayerisher Runfunks".

After playing under the baton of conductors such as Leonard Bernstein, Lorin Maazel, Carlos Kleiber, Bernard Haitink, Zubin Mehta, Carlo Maria Giulini ,Daniel Barenboim. Benoît Fromanger decided to make benefit from these musicals and socials experiences , to quite his brilliant soloist and orchestra musician's career , to studie conducting with Valéry Gergiev and prof.Rolf Reuter with whom he graduates at the Berlin hochshule.

Fromanger enjoys close relationships with many soloist artists and performed with Juliette Hurel, Corina Belcea, Idil Biret, Brigitte Engerer, François Leuleux, Wenzel Fuchs, Hans-Jeorg Rickenbacher, Bertrand Chamailoux, Bernard Soustrot, Eric Francerie, David Guerrier and Richard Galiano.

Benoit Fromanger has a particular affinity with the music of his native France, he recently recorded the Cantatas of the french composer Thierry Machuel and will start a recording collaboration between the Bucharest Symphony and the CD label "le chant de Linos".
